### 2017-2018 – Reception

In our Reception classes children spend most of their time learning and exploring through play. Our indoor and outdoor learning areas are organised so that children can access all areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum independently and with increasing challenge according to their abilities. The provision is enhanced throughout the year to target particular areas of learning. Adults interact with the children to support and further develop their learning.
