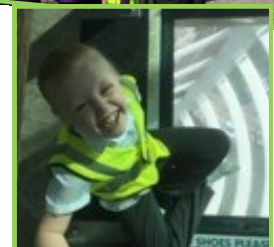
Procyon Class news
