Staying safe on the Internet - Musical.ly app

We have received a number of concerning comments about inappropriate comments and unwanted followers from children using the Musical.ly app which we would like to share with you.

This is an age 13+ social media music app where users can watch user generated lip sync video. It has over 80 millions users. The app allows users to post their own videos which can then be followed/liked by other users. In addition users can stream the app live using "live.ly".

Live.ly live streaming is not private even if you have the privacy settings set up, leaving the user open to unwanted followers and comments.

It is vital we ensure children are safe. Please discuss the use of this app with your child. If you have any concerns or questions please do not hesitate to contact your class teacher for advice
