At Barncroft Primary School, we develop successful learners who gain experiences with other languages and cultures.

Our aim is to ensure that all children make good progress through engagement and inspiration. We encourage the children to develop skills and apply these in a variety of ways of communicating in a different language.

We endeavor to encourage our children to become aware of other cultures and languages; this is implemented with a whole school approach of culture mornings. In addition, we introduce a “word of the half term”, exposing children to a range of languages over the course of the year. At the end of their journey through primary school, children will have been exposed to words in a number of different languages enabling them to draw comparisons between languages.
