School drop off and collections

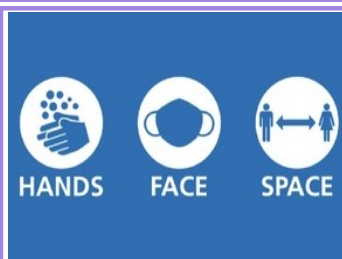
