Safer Internet Day

Safer Internet Day will be celebrated at Barncroft on Tuesday 5th February 2019. Co-ordinated in the UK by the UK Safer Internet Centre, the event will see hundreds of organizations get involved to help promote the safe, responsible and positive use of digital technology for children and young people. All children will take part in activities relating to keeping themselves safe online. The UK Safer Internet Centre - a partnership of three leading charities; Childnet, the South West Grid for Learning and the Internet Watch Foundation - provide resources for children, schools and families and tools for getting involved at www.saferinternet.org.uk.

We have also been made aware of current apps, such as Roblox, that may appear innocent but are not what they seem and can be a safeguarding concern. Please check your children's devices regularly and make sure appropriate privacy settings are in place to ensure cyber safety. If you are unsure or would like advice on any apps please come and speak to your class teacher.
