## Collecting Children Early

Note that if you need to collect your child early for a medical appointment please make sure you have contacted the school beforehand. Please also bring in the appointment letter or card so we are able to authorise the early collection. If you do not have a letter or appointment card please ask the various organisations for one. Any other reasons for early collection of your child/children cannot be authorised unless it is a family emergency.

## Important Reminders

Please do NOT let your child play on any of the gates on the school site, especially the side gate by Barnowls Pre-School. We have had reports of children banging and rattling the gate which is frightening the younger children. We also ask that parents/carers keep a watchful eye on their children's behaviour and language.

## Car Park and Car Parking

Please can we once again ask that no parent/guardian or child walks through the car park gate. Please use the main gate at the front of the school. This is for your safety as well as the children's. Note that only Blue badge holders are permitted to park in our car park to drop off and pick up children and if you have an able bodied adult in your car, please do not use the disabled bays as they are limited.
