Swimming Kits, PE Kits and Sports Day - Friday 8th June 2018

We have a number of children coming to school with **NO** swimming or PE kits, or kits that are too small for them. PE t-shirts can be bought from the office for a cost of £1.70 and are kept in stock at all times.

When we return on Monday 4th June can everyone have their kits ready with them as Sports Day is on Friday 8th June in the afternoon and all children will take part.

Important Notice - Written Consent for School Trips

The Government now requires that all schools have written consent from parents/carers for their children to take part in any school trips. This means that after the half term we will no longer be able to call you for verbal consent and if your child has not returned their consent form they will no longer be able to go on that trip.

Note that only Blue badge holders are permitted to park in our car park to drop off and pick up children and if you have an able bodied adult in your car, please do not use the disabled bays, as they are limited.

From Itchenor, the classes boarded 'Solar Heritage' (a solar powered catamaran) and enjoyed a boat trip around Chichester Harbour, looking at the different geographical features of the harbour itself.

They then travelled, by minibus, to East Head (near West Wittering) where we had lunch in the fast-appearing mist. After lunch, with the mist still obscuring the view, we then learnt about how spits were formed and explored the natural sand dunes.
