Important Notice - Written Consent for School Trips

The Government now requires that all schools have written consent from parents/carers for their children to take part in any school trips. This means that from now on we will no longer be able to call you for verbal consent and if your child has not returned their consent form they will no longer be able to go on that trip.

Car Park and Collecting/Dropping Off Children

Please can we once again ask that no parent/carer or child walks through the car park gate. Also be aware that after 8.15am no parent/carer is permitted to use the car park unless they hold a Blue badge. If you have an able bodied adult in your car, please do not use the disabled bays as they are limited.

If you are here before 8.15am and using our car park to drop off children, you must make sure that the children walk with you at all times. We have had a few instances where children have run behind or in front of cars that are reversing or pulling out.
