Pipets Mews

We have received notice from the Property Manager of Pipets Mews that they are due to have a single yellow Thermoplastic line painted throughout the Pipets Mews development on **Thursday 5**th **October 2017.** They have asked us to pass on the following information:

- Trinity Estates' contractors will attend Pipets Mews on the morning of 5th October to complete the line painting and will be on site all day. During this time, the roadway **must** be kept clear of all cars.
- The roadway of Pipets Mews is private land, therefore should only be accessed by residents and visitors of the development. Any vehicles left unattended on the development are done so at the vehicle's owners own risk. Please make it very clear to the parents that Trinity Estates, the contractor or the residents of Pipets Mews will <u>not</u> be held responsible for any damage caused to these vehicles on that day, or any day for that matter. As there will be large working team operating heavy machinery around the development, damage to vehicles is highly likely if parked on the development on that day.
- Parking enforcement will be implemented at the development following completion of the line painting. **Parking fines** will be issued to any vehicle parked on the development outside of a driveway or parking space. Trinity Estates will also be issuing visitors permits to our residents. Any vehicle parked in a visitors parking bay without a permit will also receive a parking fine.
