Our topic started with a trip to Butser Ancient Farm where we learned about how people may have lived millions of years ago. We sat in a replica Stone Age and Iron Age house. We learned 'wattling' which is a kind of weaving using hazel branches to make a fence, also we carved on chalk using sharp flints and we dug for pottery, bones and all sorts of interesting things, just like real archaeologists!
