Manners: The child that has been remembering their please and thank you. Eating nicely without talking and being respectful.

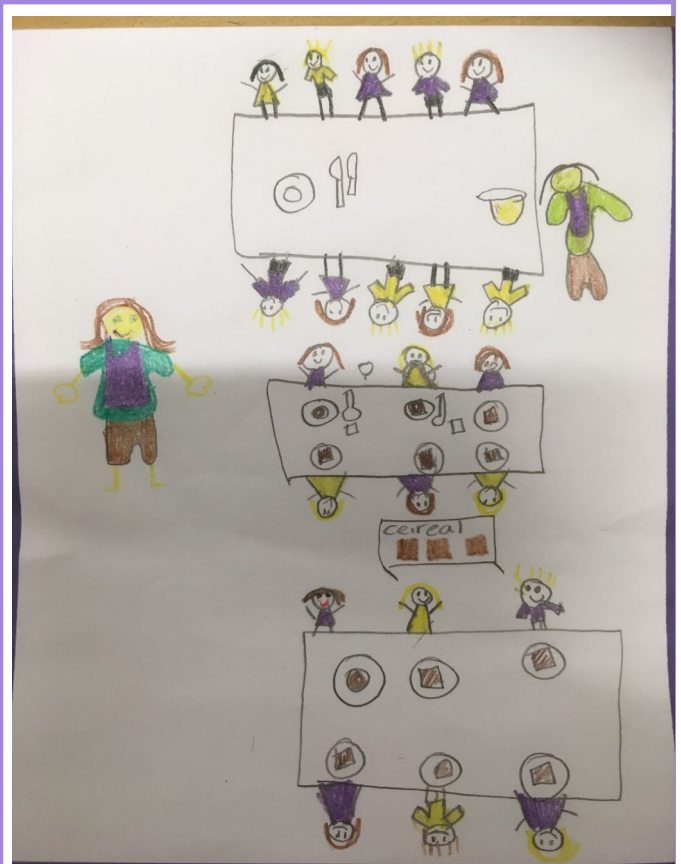
Helpfulness: The child that has been helpful to other children and also helping the adults. This can be while eating and playing.
