

What are **BARNCROFT MACs**?

MACs are our Maths Achievement Certificates. All children start on level B and then work their way through A R N C R O F T. Each level tests the children's ability to understand fluently the basic facts in Maths, increasing with difficulty in each level.

Why do we have **BARNCROFT MACs**?

Knowing Maths facts will help children to solve problems quickly and accurately. Children and parents will be able to understand the next facts that the children are working on.

How do **BARNCROFT MACs** work?

Each letter represents a group of targets to focus on. Children will work on these targets in school and at home. When the child is demonstrating all the skills of that level, they will take a short test. If successful at this test, they will receive a certificate and will move up to the next level.

How can parents and carers support their children with **BARNCROFT MACs**?

Helping children at home to practise their Maths targets will not only mean that children can enter themselves for the next test earlier, but will also have a huge impact on their overall attainment in Maths.
